June 20 - August 27, 2010

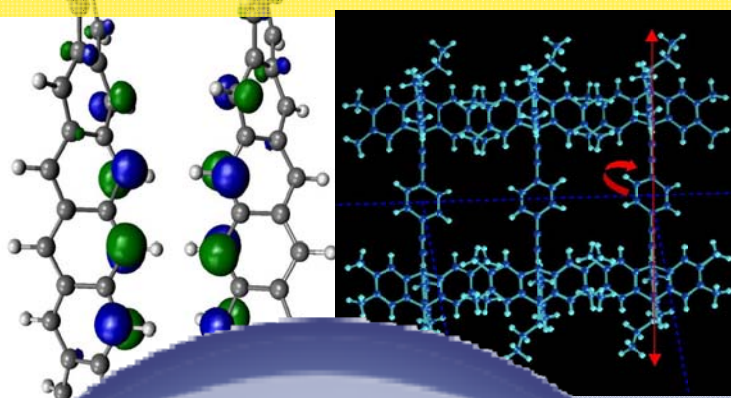
The Nanosystems Chemistry and Engineering Research (NanoCER) program at UCLA and the California NanoSystems Institute (CNSI) invite students interested in team-based interdisciplinary research to apply for the Summer 2010 program. Participants will create and characterize new materials, and develop devices and applications of nanotechnology.

Program Components

- Hands-on team-based research
- Use of sophisticated instrumentation and fabrication facilities
- Mentoring by NSF-IGERT Materials Creation Training Program graduate fellows
- Faculty seminars
- Professional skills and career workshops
- Research symposium

10-week support package includes:

- Weekly stipend
- On-campus housing
- Conference travel award



Applicants should:

- Have completed their junior year with an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Clearly articulate an interest in nanotechnology
- Show promise for success in team and leadership roles
